We will enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens.

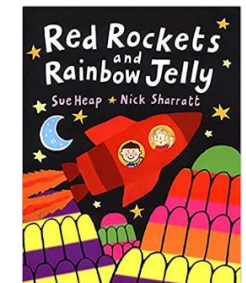
We will continue to build on knowledge of rhymes and play rhyming games.
