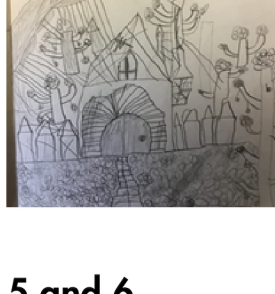
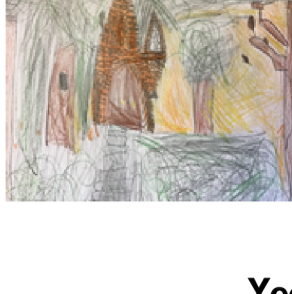
EYFS

EYFS have been reading the Supertato book this week and trying to track down the evil pea! They have also been finding out about height (looking at short and tall).



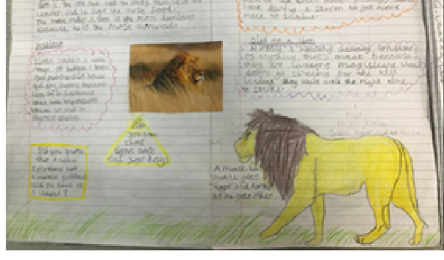
Years 1 and 2

Cherry drew some beautiful pictures of a magical fairy door recently. Here you can see some detailed sketches drawn by James and Oliver.



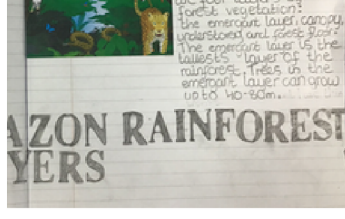
Years 3 and 4

Children have finished some more double-page spreads about the animals they have been researching. Here are some excellent versions by Elsie and William.



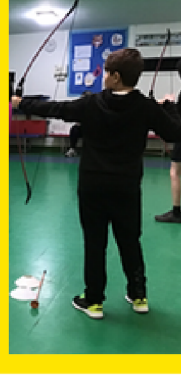
Years 5 and 6
