

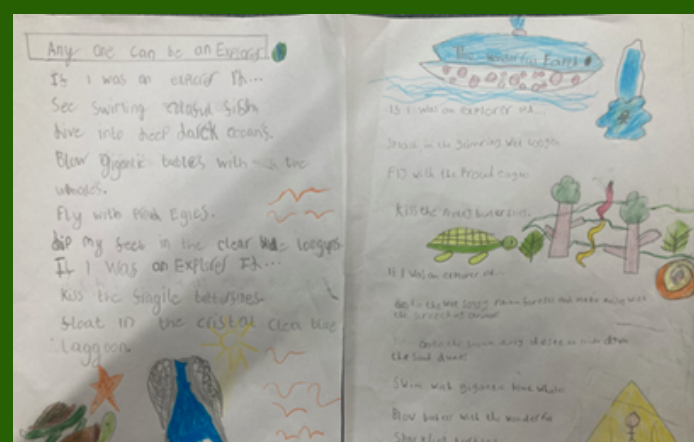


Around the School

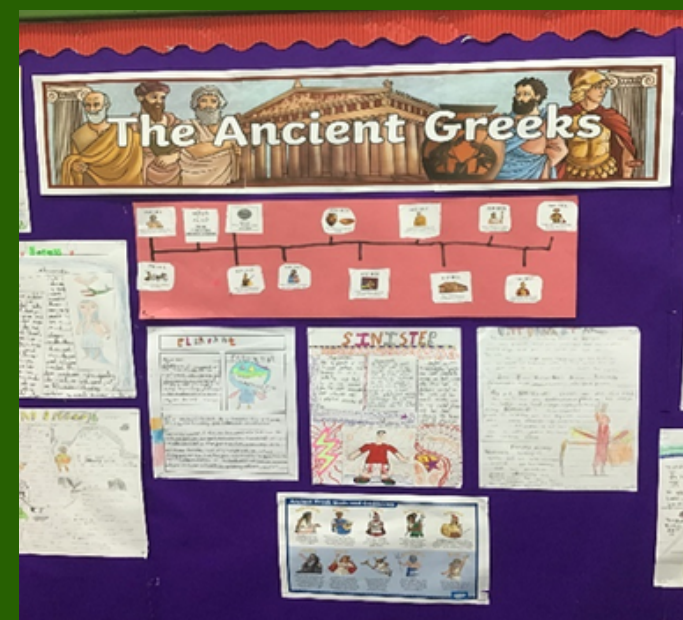

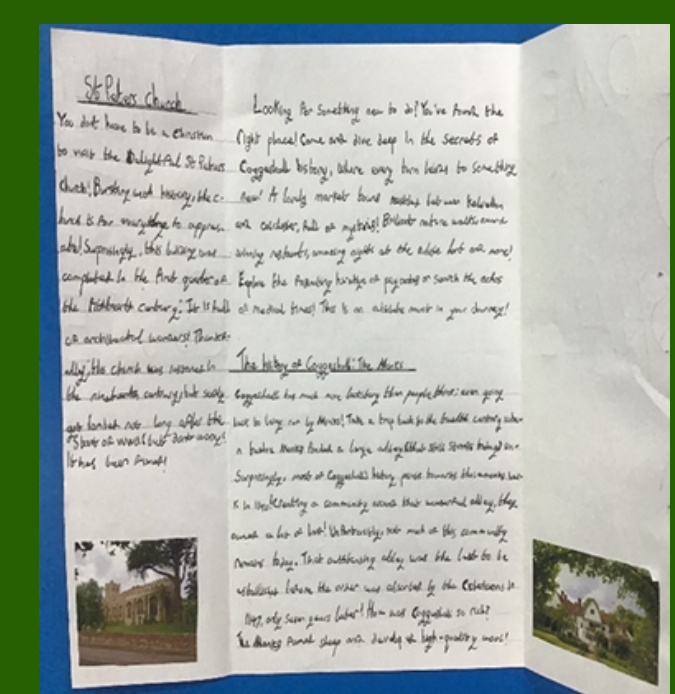
