We are thrilled to announce that our school community has not only met but exceeded our ambitious fundraising goal of £20,000. Together, we raised an incredible £22,303.06!

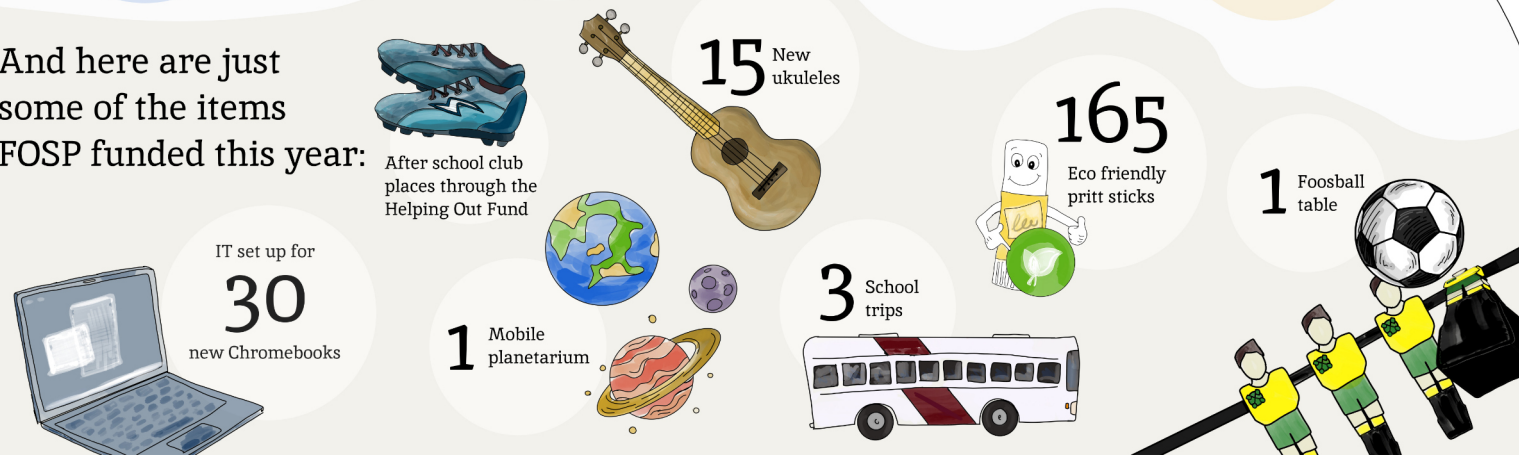
This remarkable achievement showcases the strength and unity of our school community. Check out the infographic below to see how we reached this milestone and how the funds are being used to benefit our school.
