Together we will listen to stories and rhymes. We will talk and ask questions about what we have heard.

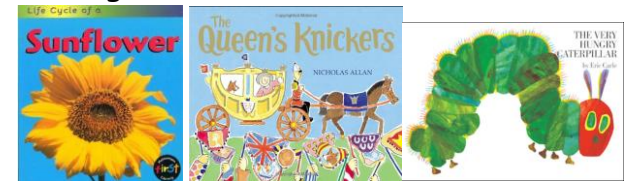
We will use language to imagine and recreate roles.
