Join us for **Christmas Jumper Day** on Wednesday 18th December. Wear your most dazzling, quirky, or downright silly Christmas jumper to school.



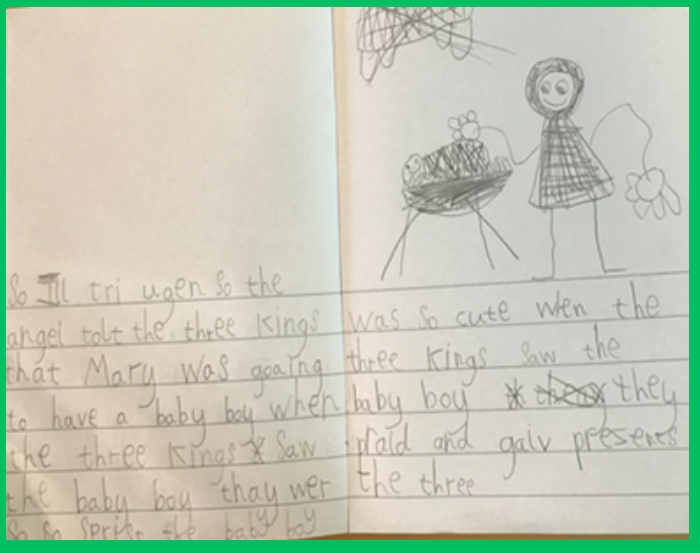
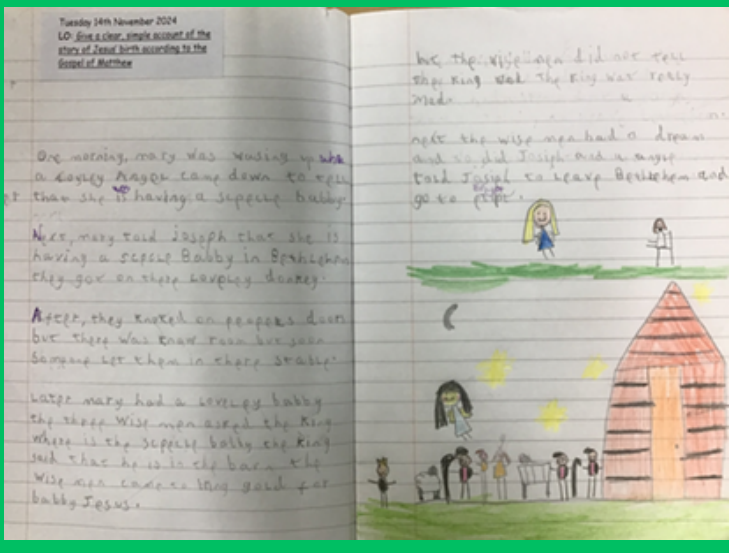

LOOK what we're LEARNING!

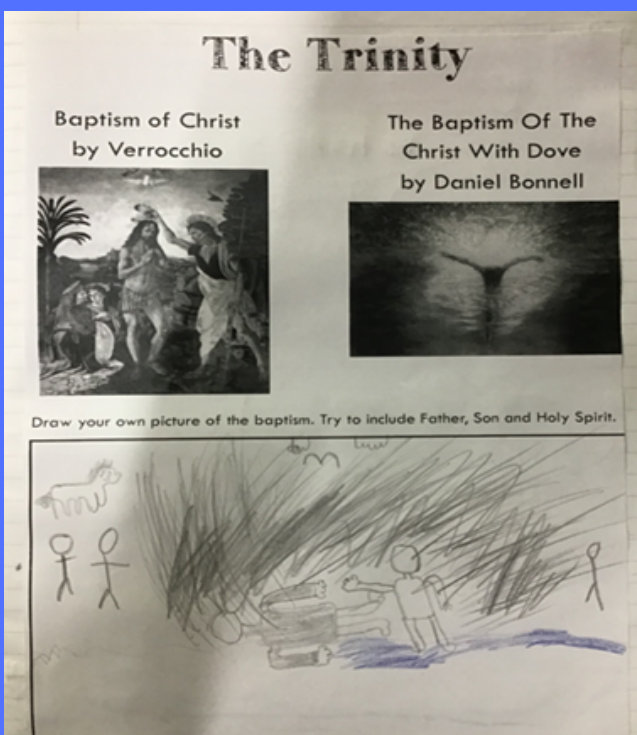
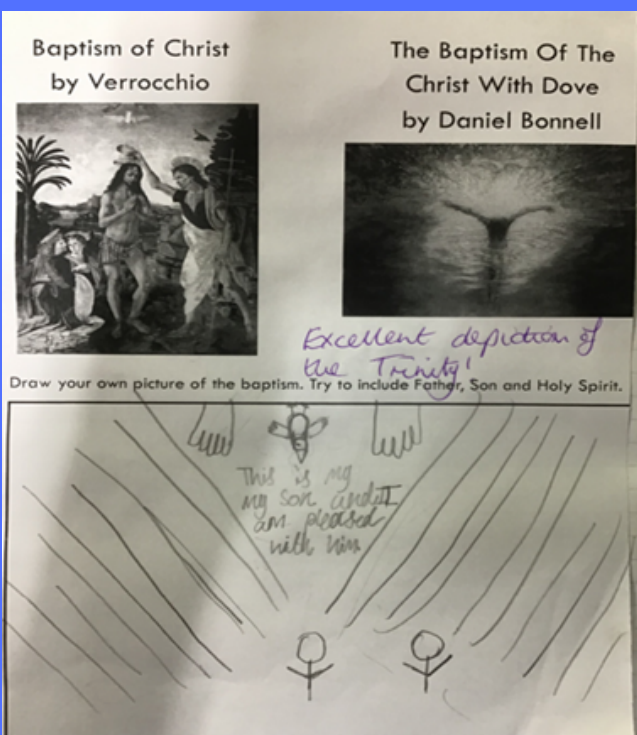
Mulberry have all been to Space this week! They have made some lovely rocket models and also done some excellent writing:
