

Mulberry have been setting up nativity scenes and writing about them. They have also helped make this lovely angel as part of the backdrop for this year's play.




Preparation for Christmas is well and truly underway! The children in years 1 and 2 have been making wreaths with cut out hand outlines.



January, we'll be holding our first 'Kaleidoscope Week'.


Through the delightful story of *The Barnabus Project*, children will explore themes of identity, acceptance, tolerance, and difference. Throughout the week, we'll have
