We will continue to build on knowledge of rhymes and play rhyming games.

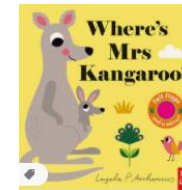
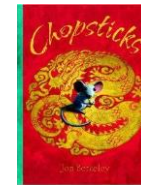
We will talk about our world.
