

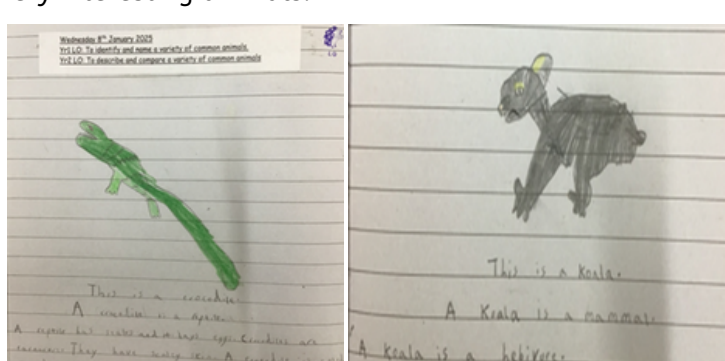


LOOK what we're LEARNING!

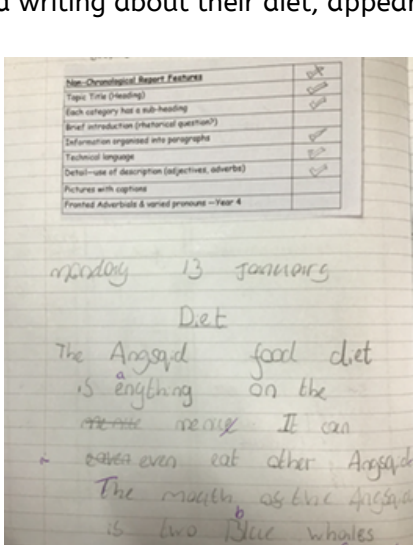
Mulberry have been reading stories about dragons this week. They decided to draw and label some maps to help the dragons find their caves and treasure.



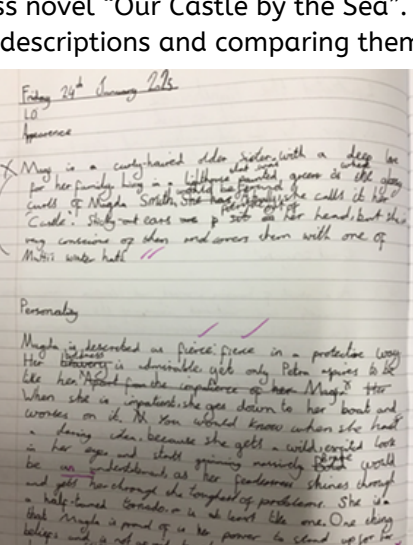
