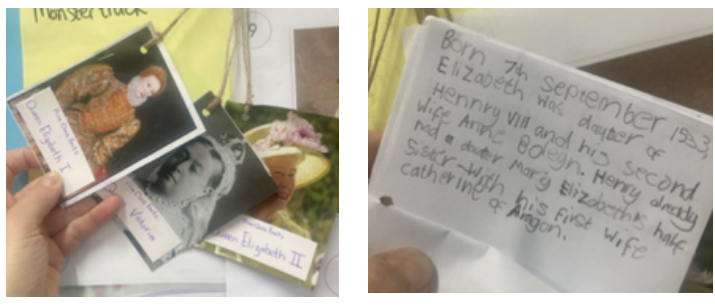

Children in Mulberry were inspired by their recent beach trip to Mersea to create these lovely sea creature sculptures:



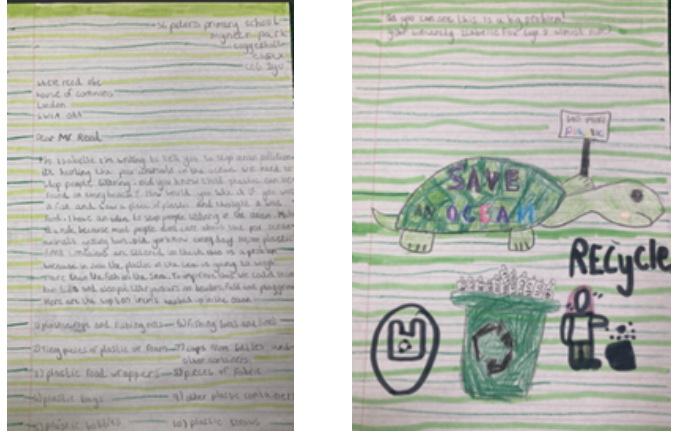
KS1

Children in Years 1 and 2 have been researching monarchs as part of their history work and have created these lovely fact booklets about some of them:



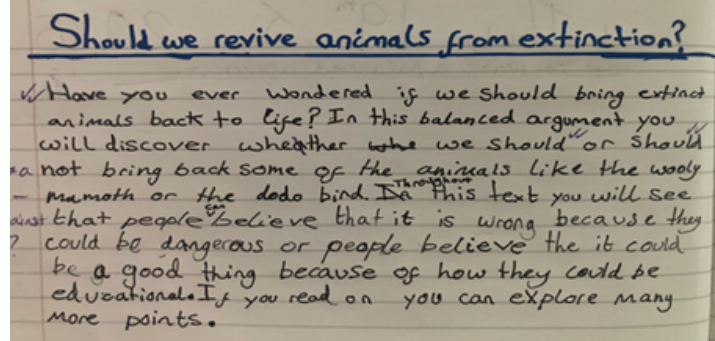
LKS2

Award-Winning International Best Selling Children's Author James Campbell will be holding writing workshops for children aged 7-11:



10am - 3pm
Wednesday 30th July

The venue is Thistle Doo Farm near Ardleigh.

Children will be led through the process of imagining, planning and writing a story, inspired by the surroundings of the off-grid farm. The particular focus for the July workshop will be around creating characters and letting the story flow from that.

Workshops cost £30 per child but there are some free places for children who receive free school meals; please just ask.

James Campbell wrote the book *Write Your Own Funny Stories* which has been translated into nearly a dozen languages to inspire children all around the world. He has visited over three thousand schools in the last thirty years, telling his stories, making everyone laugh and encouraging children to write!
